## Review | Small Group Questions

*Read Acts 4 together. This week we covered verses 1-12. Pray for wisdom as you answer and discuss the following questions.*

1. What impacts you or resonates with you in this passage? Why?
2. Read verses 1-4. What happens at the close of Peter's sermon from the previous chapter? Why does the name of Jesus cause strong reactions? In this passage some were annoyed (v2), some were arrested (v3), and some were added (v4).
3. Did the actions of men against the gospel prevent or hinder the sovereignty or power of God? How has this encouraged believers throughout history and us today?
4. What help did Peter receive in his answer to the council (v8)? How does this fulfill the words of Jesus in Luke? Read Luke 12:11-12.
5. Verse 12 speaks to the exclusivity of Jesus alone as the One who saves. Why is this doctrine such a stumbling block for some people? How do we continue to present this doctrine, salvation in Jesus alone, in truth and love?
