## Review | Small Group Questions

*Read Acts 3 together. This week we covered verses 11-16 and looked at the reaction to Peter and John healing the lame man outside the temple. Pray for wisdom as you answer and discuss the following questions.*

1. How does this story of the healing of the lame man impact you personally? What was the reaction from Peter and John as the scene developed in verses 12 and 16?
2. It's been said that *"God can do great things through people when they don't care who gets the credit."* Discuss this attitude of Peter and John and how we can model this in our lives. We frequently talk and speak about humility because it is essential to walk in humility before God and each other. Why?
3. What did Peter say that may have created a sense of conviction for those in the crowd (verses 13-15)? List the four ways that Peter told the crowd that they had rejected Jesus in these verses. How did Peter ease their sense of guilt over their conviction in verses 17-19?
