## Review | Small Group Questions

*Read Acts 3 together. This week we covered verses 17-21 and looked at Peter's gospel presentation to those gathered at Solomon's Porch. Pray for wisdom as you answer and discuss the following questions.*

1. How many different ways is Jesus referenced in Acts 3:11-26? Circle all of them. Why did Peter use different ways to address the same person? What are some of your other favorite biblical ways and names in which Jesus is referred to? Read examples such as John 1:1, 1:29 and 14:6.
2. In verses 13-15 Peter tells the people of the sins they are guilty of committing. How does he begin to offer them hope in verses 17 and 18? How is the gospel misunderstood without a proper understanding of sin and guilt? Why do you think there is constant cultural pressure to remove the sin component from the gospel? Read and discuss 2 Timothy 4:1-5.
3. According to Peter, what would be the results of repentance? How would they differ from what typically follows a guilty verdict? What blessings did Peter tell them would take place in verses 19-21 if they would repent and believe?
4. Verse 20 speaks of times of refreshing from Jesus. What does this look like in a believer's life and in the life of God's church?
